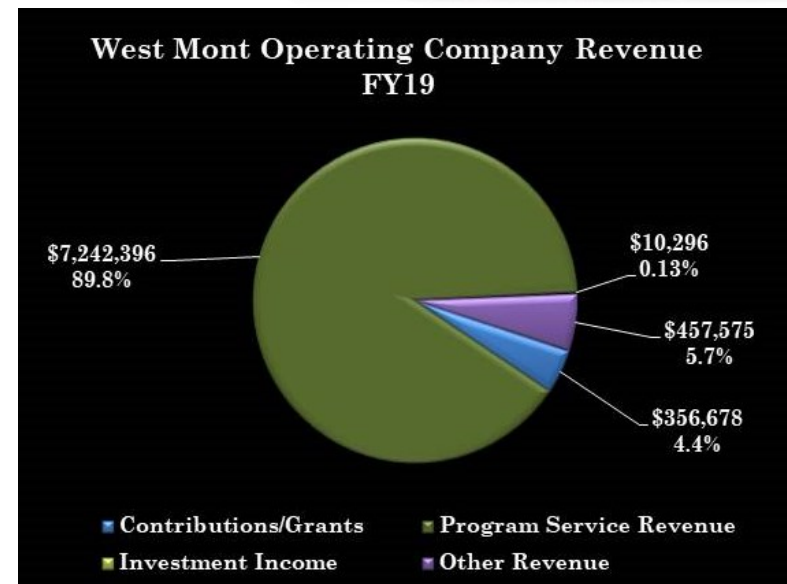

WEST MONT PROGRAMS & SERVICES

In 2019, West Mont maintained its commitment to developing and providing services to over 250 individuals with disabilities. This included operating 13-residential and 4-vocational facilities.



Residential Facilities - Our safe, comfortable homes are professionally staffed 24-hours-a-day to provide supervision, support, and to promote self-sufficiency for our 70 clients. Our Farm & Gardens home was completely renovated in 2019.

Supported Living - For clients living on their own, our staff provide the necessary support to help them live as independently as possible. Services are based on a client's need and may include assistance with personal hygiene, meal planning, cooking, shopping, money management, and safety. For some it may mean a weekly visit, for others daily.

Melodee House - is a residential respite facility where families can take a break from their caregiving duties while their loved one is being provided with professional care.

West Mont offers a wide array of vocational and employment programs for clients to choose from. Some clients enjoy working at different locations during the week. Vocational sites include:

- * **West Mont Flower & Trading Co.** - this full-service flower shop opened in 2013 with 5-clients employed. By 2019, that number increased to 16. Clients learn to make floral arrangements, go out on deliveries, help customers in the store, general clean up, and more.
- * **Blaine Work Services** - there are a variety of options for clients to choose from where they can learn basic job skills in a structured environment. Job options for clients include cubed ice for retail/wholesale sale, bulk mailing projects, and commercial shredding
- * **West Mont Farm & Gardens** - provides employment and job training in an agricultural setting for 24-people. Options include animal husbandry, 3-commercial greenhouses, vegetable, flower, and pumpkin gardens.



* **VASTT** - for those unable to hold a traditional job, this program offers unique environments to help them develop self-help skills and sensory skills.

* **Supported Employment** - our staff helps clients with finding employment in the community and can assist with on-the-job training. On average, 50 - 60 clients participate in this program each month.

Social & Recreational Activities - our clients are encouraged to be active members in the community and have lots of activities they can enjoy including social clubs, dances, community outings, Special Olympics and a Cheer Squad.
